## WHAT IS THIS PRODUCT?

**Type:** Undertaking for Collective Investment in Transferable Securities (UCITS), a subfund of the GROUPAMA SELECTION SICAV under French law. This product is a feeder fund of GROUPAMA ALPHA FIXED INCOME PLUS — OAC share sub-class (LU1891751163)

**Term:** The product was originally created for a period of 99 years. Groupama Asset Management is entitled to terminate the product unilaterally. The product may also be terminated in the event of a merger or the redemption of all its units, or if its net assets fall below the minimum amount prescribed by regulations. 85% or more of its assets will be invested at all times in GROUPAMA ALPHA FIXED INCOME PLUS shares and in cash on an ancillary basis. Its management objective is the same as that of its master fund. Its performance may be lower than that of its master fund due to its own management fees.

**Reminder of the master fund's objectives:**

*The management objective is to outperform its benchmark index, the capitalised €STR, over the recommended investment period of more than 18 months, while also seeking to achieve a 52-week historical volatility, calculated for each day, of less than 5%. To do this, the fund manager can apply active and discretionary management strategies, mainly through the implementation of arbitrage strategies on bond and monetary assets, which meet ESG (Environmental, Social and Governance) characteristics.*

**Reminder of the investment strategy of the master fund:**

*The product will mainly be invested in bond and money market vehicles from OECD, European Union or G20 countries, with the distribution optimised to achieve the investment objective. At least 50% of its assets will be invested in investment grade (with a rating equal to or higher than BBB- [S&P/Fitch] or equivalent) or high-yield (with a rating lower than BBB- [S&P/Fitch] or equivalent) securities. The Product will not invest in distressed and defaulted securities — in other words, securities with a rating lower than CCC. Securities whose rating has been downgraded to lower than CCC will at no time represent more than 20% of the net assets. The Product will invest no more than 20% of its net assets in securities from unrated issuers. The Product may invest up to 50% of its net assets in money market instruments. The Product may invest up*

*to 30% of its net assets outside of the specified geographic area. Its investments in emerging countries (excluding China) will be capped at 20% of net assets. The Product may invest a maximum of 20% of its assets in contingent convertible bonds (CoCo bonds).*

*The ESG approach applied to the Product integrates criteria pertaining to each of the Environmental (waste management etc.), Social (employee training etc.) and Governance (board independence etc.) factors, but this not a determining factor in terms of decision-making.*

*The Product's portfolio is mainly composed of fixed-income instruments from OECD, European Union or G20 countries.*

*The sensitivity range for the Product is between -4 and 4.*

*At least 50% of the Product's net assets are exposed to fixed-income instruments.*

*It may invest up to 10% of its net assets in units or shares of French or foreign UCIs.*

*The use of derivatives and securities with embedded derivatives for hedging and/or exposure purposes is permitted.*

**Redemption conditions:** You can submit redemption requests every business day until 11:00 Paris time.

**Income policy:** Accumulation.

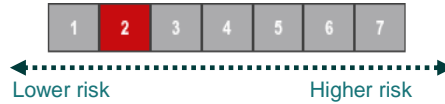

This product is not open to US Persons. This share class is reserved for investors subscribing through corporate savings and retirement schemes.

## WHAT ARE THE RISKS AND WHAT COULD I GET IN RETURN?

### RISK INDICATOR (SRI)



The risk indicator assumes that you hold the product for 18 months.

The summary risk indicator is a guide to the level of risk of this product compared to other products. It shows how likely it is that the product will lose money because of movements in the markets or because we are not able to pay you. It should be noted that the actual risk may differ if you choose to exit before the recommended investment period and maturity of the Fund, in which case you may obtain a lower yield.

We have classified this Product as 2 out of 7, which is a low risk class. This rates the potential losses from future performance at a low level, and poor market conditions are very unlikely to impact our capacity to pay you.

#### Reminder of the master fund's risks:

In addition to the risks included in the risk indicator, other risks may affect the performance of the product:

- Counterparty risk: this is the risk of a counterparty default causing said party to default on payment
- Risk associated with the use of derivatives: which may increase or decrease the Product's volatility.

### WHAT HAPPENS IF GROUPAMA AM IS UNABLE TO PAY OUT?

The product is a co-ownership of financial instruments and deposits separate from the management company. Should the Management Company default, the product's assets held by the Depositary will not be affected. Should the Depositary default, the product's risk of financial loss is mitigated due to the legal segregation of the Depositary's assets from those of the product.

### WHAT ARE THE COSTS?

#### COSTS OVER TIME

The tables show the amounts that are taken from your investment to cover different types of costs. These amounts depend on how much you invest and how long you hold the product. The amounts shown here are illustrations based on an example investment amount and different possible investment periods.

We have assumed:

– In the first year you would get back the amount that you invested (0% annual return). For the other holding periods we have assumed the product performs as shown in the moderate scenario

– an investment of €10,000.

**Recommended holding period:** 18 months
